The B-10 is primarily an anti-armour weapon that delivers an 82 mm high-explosive anti-tank warhead to ranges exceeding 2,500 m. The weapon can also fire high-explosive ammunition for use against lightly armoured vehicles, infrastructure, and personnel. The weapon's distinct, bulbous breech (rear end) is arguably its most distinctive identifying feature.

### Variants and their distinguishing features

### VARIANTS (Model/manufacturer)

- B-10, Russia
- Type 65/Type 65-1, China
- Type 78, China
- RG-82, Germany (former GDR)
- M79, former Yugoslavia

The weapon superficially resembles the Russian SPG-9, but differs in not having Bakelite (plastic) heat shields around the breech, nor a conical vent at the rear. Markings above the breech, close to the locking handle, are the best way to discriminate among types. Additionally, there are clear visual differences between the heat guards on the three most common variants: the Russian B-10, the Chinese Type 65, and a later variant, the Chinese Type 78. In general, the Russian variant features a perforated steel heat guard, while the Chinese models adopt two variations of Bakelite heat guards.

### Points to include when recording information about the weapon:

- 1. Serial number, including all prefix and suffix characters
- 2. Characters adjacent to fire selector
- 3. Any other engraved/stamped information on weapon
